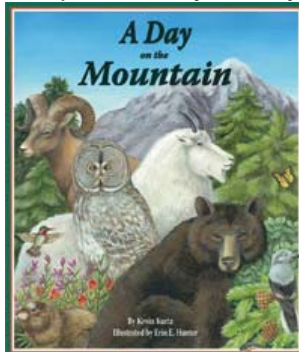
Book Launch:
