

2009 FOOTBALL PARKING PROGRAM OFFICIAL RULES & INFORMATION



The Science Factory works closely with: the City of Eugene Police, Fire, and Parks Departments; Oregon Liquor Control Commission; University of Oregon Athletic and Public Safety Departments; Lane Transit District, and other agencies to ensure safety, compliance with laws and regulations, and to provide the best parking program available. Please observe the following rules and conditions for parking in Science Factory-managed lots. *Failure to abide by these rules may result in revocation of your parking privileges, vehicle being cited or towed, or criminal prosecution.*

PARKING PASSES

- Your parking pass hangtag must be displayed on the rearview mirror or on windshield with your name, space, and member number visible from the outside. **VEHICLES WILL NOT BE ADMITTED WITHOUT A VALID PASS –NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Your parking pass is valid for the entire season – keep it in a safe place. A \$50 fee will be charged for replacement passes. Any express mail or courier charges for sending replacement passes must be pre-paid by the parking patron.
- Parking passes may not be sold or transferred.

ARRIVAL

- The Science Factory operates four parking lots during Duck football games: SF1, SF2, and SF3 (grass, south of Leo Harris Pkwy near the Science Factory building), and DYS (paved, reserved space at Department of Youth Services, north of MLK Blvd). Prior to arriving, check your assigned parking lot and plan your travel route, as streets are strictly controlled on game days.
- Vehicles will NOT be allowed to enter any parking lots until FOUR HOURS BEFORE GAME TIME. Please DO NOT arrive earlier as you will be asked to wait or circle in traffic! Game times do change, even after game times have been posted. Check on game day to ensure an appropriate arrival time. **Absolutely no overnight camping – your vehicle will be towed.**
- DO NOT DRIVE OVER CURBS. Violators may be cited and lose their parking privileges. Follow directions when entering and exiting the lot.

FINDING YOUR SPACE

- DYS parkers will be directed to their numbered spots. For the SF lots, Elks Lodge volunteers will direct your vehicle to a row or space. Park in the space to which you are assigned or directed. EMERGENCY VEHICLE LANES MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES. Vehicles blocking an emergency lane or parked in the wrong space will be towed.
- **No spots may be “saved” for other vehicles:** if you wish to be adjacent to other vehicles, please meet up off-site in advance with your party at a designated area (we recommend Alton Baker Park) and enter the parking lot together. Due to the particulars of the parking lots, Elks volunteers may designate a parking area as saved for certain vehicles due to space issues. The Elks volunteer parkers have full discretion to park your vehicle in the manner they deem appropriate. Please cooperate fully.

DEPARTURE

- Expect delays of up to one hour after games. Traffic flow is controlled by police. Vehicles may be prevented from exiting the parking lot between the fourth quarter of games and continuing up to 30 minutes after games due to pedestrian and bus traffic. Please observe all parking lot personnel directions and cooperate with this delay.
- DO NOT DRIVE OVER CURBS. Violators may be cited and lose their parking privileges. Follow directions when entering and exiting the lot.
- **Absolutely no overnight camping – your vehicle will be towed.**

DURING YOUR STAY

ALCOHOL:

- Providing alcohol to minors and consumption of alcohol by minors is prohibited.
- USE A DESIGNATED DRIVER IF YOU PLAN TO CONSUME ALCOHOL.
- **SF LOTS:** In accordance with amendments to Eugene Code Section 4.190 (full text on last page), consumption of beer and wine is allowed in the Science Factory lots **only on game day and ending when the game is completed.** **No glass containers are allowed in these lots, due to park safety concerns.**
- **DYS LOTS:** In accordance with amendments to Eugene Code Section 4.190 (full text on last page), consumption of beer and wine is allowed in the DYS lots, **only on game day and ending when the game is completed.** **No glass containers are allowed in these lots, due to safety concerns.** DYS requests that parking patrons use discretion in their consumption of alcohol due to the nature of their facilities. Please be respectful of DYS, their services, and their patrons by exercising maturity, good judgment, and tact if you consume alcohol.

BEHAVIOR:

- Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated and may result in eviction from lot and loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the season or permanently, with no refund of parking fees.
- Parking patrons who encounter inappropriate or unsafe behavior should notify parking lot personnel of the situation as soon as possible.

CANOPIES/TENTS:

- **SF LOTS:** **No pavilion tents** in the grass lots. **Canopy tent size must be limited to a maximum of 10' x 10'.** No open flame devices are allowed inside tents and canopies.
- **DYS LOTS:** **Yes, pavilion tents** may be pitched in the paved parking area (when an additional space has been purchased). Tents must not extend into driving lanes within the parking lot. No open flame devices are allowed inside tents and canopies.

FIRES/GRILLS:

- **SF LOTS:** **No charcoal, wood, or open fires** on the ground. However, gas or propane grills or stoves may be used off the ground, on the back of an open pick-up truck or metal table. No open flame devices are allowed inside tents and canopies.
- **DYS LOTS:** **Yes, charcoal barbecues and gas grills** are permitted at DYS. No open flame devices are allowed inside tents and canopies.

GUEST LIMIT:

- **Limit of 10 guests per space.** Vehicles are allowed a maximum of 10 persons associated with one parking space. Parties exceeding this number and caterer-sponsored events are prohibited.

OVERSIZED VEHICLES/MOTOR HOMES/RVs:

- **Any Oversized vehicles** (vehicles w/trailers, campers, motor homes,) **must have a Motor Home Pass**, and may park **only** in designated areas of the SF2 or SF3 Grass Lots.
- Maximum size for any vehicle is **40 feet** (this includes trailer and vehicle combined).
- Oversized vehicles should plan to arrive no later than 3 hours before game time in order to allow for ease in parking.
- A Motor Home Pass **may** be used with a car. Car pass **may not** be used with oversized vehicles.

RESTROOMS:

- Porta-potties are located in the SF1 and SF2 lots, and on both ends of the DYS lot. SF3 patrons can use the restrooms in either of the SF lots. *Please be aware that there will be lines at the restrooms during times of peak use.* Please plan accordingly.

- Portable toilets in SF lots will be locked one hour after games.

SAFETY AND SECURITY:

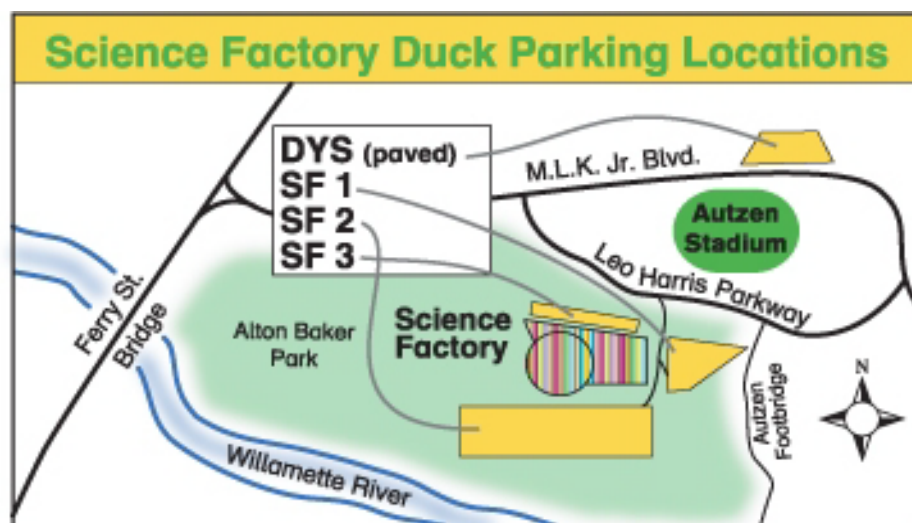
- **Lock your vehicle:** The Science Factory, Lane County, and the City of Eugene are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Lock valuables in the trunk or take them with you.
- **Please use caution** when walking from the parking areas to the stadium or game-related activities. Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- **Lost and found** will be located at east and west ends of main concourse (Autzen); afterwards, call U of O Public Safety at 541-346-5444.
- **Notify parking lot personnel immediately of any safety issues.**

TRASH:

- Please pick up after yourself and your group! The SF parking lots are located within a public park and our facility is open on Sunday mornings. Trash receptacles are provided, so please use them.

Please note the following rules related to alcohol consumption enacted in 2007 in accordance with Eugene City Council amendments to Eugene Code Section 4.190:

1. It is illegal to consume alcoholic liquor or possess an open alcoholic beverage container in a public place or on private property extended to the public for use;
2. An exemption is provided for the consumption of alcoholic beverages on this property during the time period commencing four hours before the start of a scheduled collegiate football game at Autzen Stadium and **ending when the game is completed**;
3. The exemption applies only to the parking area on this property;
4. Providing alcohol to minors and consumption of alcohol by minors is prohibited;
5. The sale of alcohol is prohibited;
6. Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated; and
7. Persons violating the law or creating a nuisance are subject to eviction and loss of parking privileges pursuant to the authority of parking lot operator.
