Exhibit Hall

Field Trips can be scheduled Tuesday-Friday, between 9 am and 4 pm. Anticipate 45 minutes to 1 hour for students to enjoy the museum exhibits. Special arrangements for additional hours may be possible. \$60 for groups under 20, or \$3 per student for groups over 20. (*Pricing for the Exhibit Hall plus Exploration Dome is \$100 flat rate for small groups or \$5 per person for groups of 20 or more students.*)

Exploration Dome Show

Exploration Dome shows are available Tuesday-Friday between 10 am and 3 pm. Special arrangements for additional hours are possible. Live planetarium shows are available Wednesday-Friday. Live planetarium shows listed below are presented by the Planetarium Director, while Dome movies listed below are digital movies specially made to be projected on the dome. All shows are geared toward ages 8 to adult, except Our Solar System and Tonight’s Sky, which are appropriate for any age group. See show lengths after titles below. Allow for arrival 15 minutes prior to the start of your show. The Exploration Dome holds a maximum of 70 people. \$60 for groups under 20, or \$3 per student for groups over 20. (*See pricing note above for both Exhibit Hall and Exploration Dome.*)

Field Trip Enrichment Lab

A 45-minute hands-on classroom experience led by a Science Factory educator. \$30 for up to 15 students, \$2 per student for 16-24 students. Maximum of 24 per class, though larger groups can schedule multiple classes back-to-back. At least one adult chaperone must assist with each class. Please check our website for additional field trip enrichment lab options.

Fossil Lab (Grades 1 - 3): Students will learn how fossils form, see and touch different types of fossils, and find out some of the information scientists gather from fossil evidence.

Dinosaur Mythbusters Lab (Grades 4 - 6): Students will explore what scientists know and don’t know about dinosaurs, including information about age, size, appearance, environment, and diversity. The class works together to correct some common misconceptions about dinosaurs.
